## **Board of Education Student Representative**

The SHS student representatives will serve as liaisons to the Board of Education. The student representatives will provide insight and support to the Board's understanding of student issues and perspectives.

### Term

October 1, 2021 - June 30, 2022 (2021 - 2022 - a one-year term of the school year of their appointment)

# **Student Expectations/Role**

Student members of the Board of Education are expected to represent the student body and the BOE within the following parameters:

- 1. Regular attendance at Board Meetings
- 2. Participation in the discussion of school issues before the Board
- 3. The student members shall not vote on matters before the Board of Education but may express viewpoints during the discussion
- 4. The student members shall not participate in Executive Sessions of the Board of Education
- 5. The student members may suggest agenda topics to the Superintendent of Schools or the BOE Chairperson
- 6. Student(s) will become knowledgeable about Board policies and procedures
- 7. Student(s) will understand and follow the Board Code of Ethics and Robert's Rules of Order
- 8. The student members will be welcomed to attend standing and ad-hoc committee meetings
- 9. The student members will report back to the student council and the student body regularly.
- 10. The student's monthly report will be submitted to the Superintendent and Board of Education Chairman no later than Thursday before the regularly scheduled Board of Education meeting

## **Qualifications/Requirement**

- The student must have a 3.0 weighted GPA average or higher and must maintain that average (or higher) throughout their tenure as a non-voting member of the Board of Education.
- The student must submit 2 letters of recommendation from the student's current or former teachers for approval of their candidacy. These letters can be directly submitted from the teacher to Mrs. Riddle.
- The student(s) may not have excessive absences or tardies and must be a student in good standing.

### **Process**

- 1. Interested students must complete and submit the application, and other required materials by Wednesday, September 22.
- 2. Students who meet the qualifications will be presented to the student body for elections. Each candidate will submit a 1-minute video clip for election purposes by 8:00 a.m. Wednesday, September 22 to Mrs. Riddle.
- 3. One student (grades 9-10) and one student (grades 11-12) will be elected by their peers.
