After all presentations are completed, a 10 - 20 minute debate will take place in which you can advocate for your video to be selected for one of the categories below. You may only advocate for one. Then at the end of the debate period, each student can choose one presentation that you feel best exemplified each category. You may vote for the same presentation for more than one category, but only one per category. You may NOT vote for your own video in any category except the one you advocated for in the debate period. The presentation that receives the most votes for each category will receive 2 bonus points on their final score.
